

# ROCKET CITY SWIM LEAGUE

## MINUTES

**Wednesday, April 11, 2006**

The first meeting of the 2006 RCSL swim season was called to order at the YMCA by Holly Holder, President. The time was 7:10 p.m. Beth Morris, 1<sup>st</sup> VP City Meet, Joe Scrip, 2<sup>nd</sup> VP Swim, Tommy Kibler, 2<sup>nd</sup> VP Dive, Christie Kubichan, Records, and Judy Satterfield, Secretary, were present. Scott Cardno was absent. A swim team representative roll call was taken. Lily Flagg, Valley Hill Country Club, and the YMCA were absent. The minutes from the August 18, 2005 meeting were approved. The RCSL board and all pool representatives that were present introduced themselves. The 2006 RCSL meetings, dual and city meet schedules were unanimously accepted by all present.

The following topics were discussed and or proposed:

1. Members were encouraged to utilize the RCSL website, [www.swimrcsl.org](http://www.swimrcsl.org).
2. The names of any known past swim record holders were asked to be submitted to the President for historical archives.
3. Teams were encouraged to schedule off and "B" meets.
4. Team dues are \$325 for swim and \$100 for dive teams and are due at the May 23, 2006 meeting.
5. A quantity of duel meet exhibition ribbons will be provided to all teams, with additional ribbons to be available for purchase from RCSL.
6. A suggestion was made to use RCSL revenue to improve the loudspeaker system at the Natatorium for City Meet.
7. City meet ribbons will be furnished for all participants.
8. Starter boxes were requested to be provided by RCSL for dual meets. There was no decision made.
9. The City Meet team jobs, improvement ideas such as moving some events from Saturday to Sunday and the tent layout was discussed.
10. Reps were reminded that a strict due date for heat sheet ads will be adhered to this year and teams were encouraged to take pictures as soon as the season starts for ads.
11. All teams must have a computer designee to be responsible for maintaining the Meet and Team manager programs. The upgrade cost is \$189.00 and is not mandatory at this time.
12. Officials training and test information was presented. All tests must be submitted by May 22, 2006 to Joe Scrip.
13. The dates for the next meetings are May 23<sup>rd</sup> and June 27<sup>th</sup>. City Meet entries are due at Camelot Pool on July 7th.

The City Meet dates for 2006 are July 14 – 16<sup>th</sup>. Holly Holder, President adjourned the meeting at 8:30 p.m.
