Scoring: Chris discussed options for dual meet supplies. In the past, RCSL Scoring would bulk purchase all dual meet supplies for scoring (pink, blue, yellow note cards and labels). Due to each team having surplus supplies, it was recommended that each team purchase their own supplies as needed. Hytek training will be available during May to train new volunteers for the teams. Experienced users should attend these trainings, but it is not mandatory.

City Meet: Caroline discussed the necessity of raising the City Meet entry fees from \$1.25 to a possible \$2.00 per event to adjust for increases in rental/supplies fees. Increased expenses will be evaluated and teams should know the City Meet entry fees by the next meeting for their planning purposes.
